Free Shred Event and non-perishable food drive on Saturday, May 3rd

at our Sparta Branch from 8:00 - 11:00 am

- Free secure shredding of outdated sensitive documents such as financial statements, check duplicates, receipts, invoices, etc.
- We are also holding a food drive if you wish to donate a non-perishable food item to benefit a local food pantry. Donating is voluntary.
- All shredding will be done on-site at 1000 W. Wisconsin Street in Sparta by the Confidential Records, Inc. mobile shredding truck. This event is open to the public.
- · Please follow these shredding guidelines:
 - 1) Up to 3 boxes/bags of shredding (100 lbs) per person
 - 2) All types of paper are fine, but ONLY PAPER is accepted (no disks or other hard objects, no 3-ring binders or hard covers). Staples and paper clips do not need to be removed, but please remove butterfly clips.
 - **3)** Please consult your tax professional for advice on tax return and records retention. Also, never destroy documents tied to pending litigation or vital records such as wills, deeds, titles, birth or death certificates.

- 1st CCU Anywhere Online & Mobile Banking and Online Bill Pay will be temporarily unavailable during this time.
- ATM withdrawals will be limited to \$100 and point-of-sale transactions will be limited to \$1500 during this time.

Lucas Fanning promoted to Loan Officer I





64th Annual Meeting

1st Community Credit Union held its 64th Annual Meeting on March 31, 2025 at Sparta American Legion Post 100 in Sparta, WI.

The 42 member-owners attending the meeting elected two directors, Doug Allen and Claire Sweet, to three-year terms.



Treasurer Phil Yahnke reported on the Credit Union's Financial Condition. 2024's growth brought assets to over \$266 million dollars. Members' deposits are federally insured by NCUA. The credit union issued loans totaling \$84.9 million in 2024. Since forming in 1961 the credit union has loaned out over \$1.7 billion dollars to members.

President Brad Bauges discussed the Don't Tax My Credit Union grassroots outreach and encouraged members to visit the website at donttaxmycreditunion.org. Other highlights shared by Mr. Bauges and members of the Management team included an upcoming remodel of the Sparta branch, plans for rolling out a Mobile Wallet service later in the year, as well as a new Add-On Youth Certificate coming soon. Members were also encouraged to take advantage of resources provided by the credit union to help members learn about avoiding fraud.

The Board of Directors then took several great questions from members. 1st CCU remains financially sound, and the partnership between the members and the staff continue to drive the credit union to be strong.

of the Credit Union)





PERKS OF MEMBERSHIP

1st CCU members qualify for a discounted admission to Noah's Ark Waterpark. The Promo Code is exclusive for 1st CCU members and cannot be posted publicly on our website, so we'll be sending the code in a message posted to 1st CCU Anywhere Online & Mobile Banking around May 23, 2025. If you don't have access to get the code within 1st CCU Anywhere you may contact 1st CCU during regular business hours this summer to ask for the Promo Code.

To use the Noah's Ark Promo Code:

- Tickets must be purchased on the NoahsArkWaterpark.com website. Click 'Buy Tickets' button, then select 'Tickets'.
- Select your ticket choice and quantity. Scroll down and enter the Promotional Code. Click 'Apply', then 'Continue'.
- Your discounted ticket price will show as \$34.99 plus tax (\$37.35) per ticket after the Promo Code is applied.
- Offer valid May 24 September 1, 2025*.
